North Fond du Lac Police Department Offers Community Protection and Informational Meetings

The Police Department will be offering two different community informational meetings in May. Both meetings will provide an excellent opportunity for citizens of the community to learn more about crime in the Village of North Fond du Lac, issues affecting it, and to get better acquainted with police department officials.

The first of these meetings will be a presentation on child abductions and critical information that parents need to know to help protect their children from becoming victims of abduction. Additionally, attendees will be given a general overview of the police department's response plan for these types of incidents, including a presentation on the newly enacted 'Wisconsin Amber Alert' system. No parent should miss this meeting! This meeting will begin at 6:30PM on May 20th and will be held in the School District Board Room, located at 225 McKinley Street, North Fond du Lac, WI. Chief William Lamb and School Resource Officer Troy Damsteegt will be giving this presentation.

Want to know what types of criminal activity are happening in your neighborhood? Did you know that, as a resident or business owner in the Village of North Fond du Lac, you have your own personal Neighborhood Officer? Want to get to know your Neighborhood Officer? Did you know that the North Fond du Lac Police Department has won prestigious state wide awards, in two of the past three years, for its initiatives and effectiveness in protecting the community? If you want answers or additional information regarding these or other questions, you should plan on attending the meeting which will be held on Thursday, May 15th, 2003. This meeting will be held at the North Fond du Lac Community Center (280 Garfield Street), and will begin at 6:30PM.

The main topic of presentation and discussion at the May 15th meeting will be an overview of criminal activity in the Village of North Fond du Lac. In addition to providing overall crime statistics for the Village, there will also be a neighborhood

by neighborhood crime analysis provided. This analysis will show residents and business owners specifically what types of criminal activity are occurring in their immediate neighborhood. Additionally, the program will entail an overview of the police department's multi award winning neighborhood policing program, information on how the citizens of the Village can use the program to better protect themselves, their families, and their property, and crime prevention tips that everyone should know. The presentation will end with a question and answer session. The presentation will be given by Chief William Lamb. Some of the Neighborhood Officers will also be in attendance, for those interested in meeting or talking with them.

The North Fond du Lac Police Department takes great pride in the outstanding working relationships that it's developed with the citizens and business owners of the community. Additionally, the department recognizes that maintaining open and effective lines of communication with those that we serve and protect are a key component in continuing to build even stronger community partnerships.
