On December 20th, officers of the department will begin delivering approximately one week's worth of groceries, including a complete Christmas turkey dinner and gifts for children, to area families that the department has "adopted".

Each year the employees of the police department look forward to having this opportunity to brighten the holiday season for area families that are in need of a little assistance. Chief William Lamb stated, "This is so important to us because it's an opportunity to help others, and it allows for the police to interact with residents in a more positive light."

Already this year the Police Benevolent Association has received non-perishable food items from the Bessie Allen Middle School and the North Fond du Lac High School, and a monetary donation from Presentation Church. Additionally, Community United Methodist Church in NFDL is once again purchasing gifts for the families and St. Paul's Lutheran Church in NFDL has committed to making a monetary donation.
