On August 15, 2005 at about 4:35 pm, officers from the North Fond du Lac Police Department were dispatched to 63 Captains Cove because a neighbor had noticed that 2 windows were broke out and they heard glass breaking and did not know if the resident was at home. Upon the first officers arrival, she saw a male break out the front window from the inside of the residence. The Fond du Lac Police Department also provided assistance.

The officer saw the male exit the back door of the residence carrying a basket. The officer told the male to put the basket down. The male put the basket down, shrugged his shoulders and walked back inside the residence.

Officers surrounded the residence and attempted to make contact with the male. Officers learned that the male resident has had a history of mental problems. At one point, officers spoke to the male through an open window. The male refused to exit the residence and told officers to go away and then he closed the window and refused to talk any longer. Officers gained entry into the residence and took the male into custody without incident. Officers did find that gas was left on and the residence did smell of natural gas. They also found that the interior of the residence was damaged.

The male was transported the Fond du lac County Health Care Center on a 72 hour hold.
