On Saturday, August 13, 2005, officers of the North Fond du Lac Police Department were dispatched to Toon Town Tap located at 48 Harrison Street for a report of a suspicious male carrying an ice pick and threatening patrons.

When officers arrived, they located a subject matching the description given by witnesses, exiting the bar. Officers made contact with John W.O. Lund, a 43-year-old Fond du Lac area man. The intoxicated Lund ignored the verbal commands given by the police and began to walk away. When one of the officers tried getting Lund to stop, Lund kicked his foot backwards, striking the officer in his left shin.

Lund, who continued to physically resist arrest and kick at the officers was eventually secured and taken into custody. The officer that was kicked sustained non-life threatening injuries that did not require emergency medical treatment.

Lund threatened to kill officers and also said he had killed someone earlier in the night. Officers found that Lund had some blood on his shirt and abrasions to his hands. This was later determined to have come from a dog biting Lund at his residence earlier in the evening.

Lund is currently being held in the Fond du Lac County Jail on charges of Carrying a Concealed Weapon and Battery to a Law Enforcement Officer.
