At approximately 7:16P.M. on Thursday, April 16, 2009, the North Fond du Lac Police and Fire Department were dispatched to a report of a fire at 1050 Lakeshore Drive in the Village of North Fond du Lac, WI. That address is the site of the former Lagoon Exotic Dance Club, which has been closed for several years and has been a vacant property.

Responding officers initially observed smoke coming from the building, but shortly after arrival reported flames visible through the roof. The North Fond du Lac Fire Department responded and requested mutual aid assistance from the City of Fond du Lac Fire Department, Van Dyne Fire Department, Town of Fond du Lac Fire Department, and the Town of Eldorado Fire Department.

No injuries or deaths have been reported or discovered as a result of this fire. The building was completely destroyed by the fire.

The cause of the fire remains under active investigation. The North Fond du Lac Police Department contacted the State of Wisconsin, Department of Justice – Division of Criminal Investigation/Fire Marshall's Office and requested that they lead the investigation. An investigator from the Fire Marshall's Office has been assigned to the case.
