The North Fond du Lac Police Department recently took a report of a possible financial scam. The reporting individual received a telephone call from a male who said he was calling to offer protection on credit cards. The caller claimed that forms had been sent to the individual's residence, but they probably had not been received yet. He stated that after the forms were completed and returned, stickers would be sent and should be attached to the credit cards. The caller requested the individual provide him with their checking account number. When this request was denied, he threatened to report the individual to their credit card company and hung up. The reporting individual believed the caller was in his sixties and had a deep voice with no accent. The male also made a reference to Missouri.
